

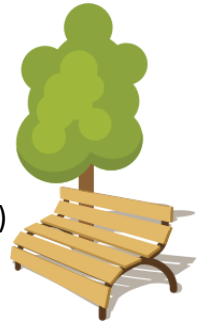
Walk and Talk 1 - Focus on Creation



- Look around and talk about all the different and interesting creatures, critters, and creations God has made.
- Observe the detail in God's creation by counting how many different colors you see in nature, the patterns of the leaves on a branch, or number of petals on a flower.
- Look for signs of new life in things that look dead from winter.
- Take a walk at night and focus on the moon, stars, sky, and night creatures.

Think

- Discuss how God is the source and sustainer of all life.
- Ask, "How does the creation show different attributes of God?"
