Classroom Management for the TEACHER

Real Time



DO	DO NOT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Come early to help set up and hear instructions for the day. • Stay to help until the job is done and the kids are gone, not just when the class time ends. • Talk with the kids before and after class, instead of your personal friends. • Delegate responsibilities to help everyone know they have a job, if you are the leader. • Look for needs to meet without being asked. • Remember that every member of the team needs to stay with the group. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get so engrossed talking with your co-teachers before or after class that you forget to help set up or clean up. • Talk in the back of the room or leave the room when it is not your turn to teach. • Leave the same person to do the clean up every time, while you enjoy your chit-chat. • Leave a teacher alone with a minor. • Be on your cell phone.

Classroom Management for the TEAM

1. Sit with the kids.
2. Be aware of what the other teachers are doing.
3. Help with crowd control.

Classroom Management for the STUDENT

1. Make sure that the rules for the class and the consequences for breaking those rules are clearly stated so they know your expectations.
2. Move the child somewhere else, away from the distraction (like his friends) or have him sit in the back or next to a teacher.
3. Discipline or praise students based on their character.
4. Discipline techniques
5. If things do not improve, for the sake of the class, you may have to remove that child from the class.
