

# HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE NATIONAL BIBLE BEE COMPETITION QUALIFYING TEST

As you prepare for the Qualifying Test, here is the breakdown on what to study based on the Summer Study Participant Guidebook:

- The participant should complete the Discovery Journal (both NAVIGATE and EXPLORE).
- The participant should memorize the Summer Study memory passages, and study them in their context.
- The participant should study and memorize any original language (Hebrew/Greek) words in the Discovery Journal. They do not need to know Strong's Number.
- The participant should study the cross-references in context (outside from their use in the Discovery Journal) from the provided Cross-Reference List.
