

Instructions: Print out a set of prophecy slips (pages 1-8). Take the set to a print shop like UPS and get sets printed so that pages 1-4 are on the front side and pages 5-8 are on the back side of the corresponding 1-4 pages. For example: *01 Prophecy –Place of Birth* will be on the front side and *01 Prophecy Fulfilled – Place of Birth* will be on the back side. Cut each prophecy into slips. Print on heavier paper if available.

01 – Prophecy - Place of Birth

Micah 5:2 “But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old from ancient times.”

02 – Prophecy - Heir to the Throne of David

Isaiah 9:7 “Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the Lord Almighty will accomplish this.”

03 – Prophecy - Born of a Virgin

Isaiah 7:14 “Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.”

04 – Prophecy - Killing of Infants

Jeremiah 31:15 “This is what the Lord says: “A voice is heard in Ramah, mourning and great weeping, Rachel weeping for her children and refusing to be comforted, because her children are no more.”

05 – Prophecy - Escape into Egypt

Hosea 11:1 “When Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt I called my son.”

06 – Prophecy - Ministry in Galilee

Isaiah 9:1-2 “Nevertheless, there will be no more gloom for those who were in distress. In the past he humbled the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the future he will honor Galilee of the Gentiles, by the way of the sea, along the Jordan— The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned.”

07 – Prophecy - As a Prophet

Deuteronomy 18:15 “The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own brothers. You must listen to him.”

08 – Prophecy - His Rejection by Jews

Isaiah 53:3 “He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.”

09 – Prophecy - His Characteristics

Isaiah 11:2 “The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.”

10 – Prophecy - His Triumphal Entry

Zechariah 12: 13-14 “Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.”

11 – Prophecy - Betrayed by a Friend

Psalms 41:9 “Even my close friend, whom I trusted, he who shared my bread, has lifted up his heel against me.”

Dec 12 - Prophecy- Silent when Accused

Isaiah 53:7 “He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth.”

Dec 13 - Prophecy- Struck and Spat on

Isaiah 50:6 “I offered my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who pulled out my beard; I did not hide my face from mocking and spitting.”

Dec 14 - Prophecy- Suffered Vicariously

Isaiah 53:4-5 “Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted.”

Dec 15 - Prophecy- Crucified with Sinners

Isaiah 53:12 “Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.”

Dec 16 - Prophecy- Hands and Feet Pierced

Psalms 22:16 “Dogs have surrounded me; a band of evil men has encircled me, they have pierced my hands and my feet.”

Dec 17 - Prophecy- Mocked and Insulted

Psalms 22:6-8 “But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by men and despised by the people. All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads: “He trusts in the Lord; let the Lord rescue him. Let him deliver him, since he delights in him.”

18 – Prophecy - Prays for his Enemies

Psalms 109:4 “In return for my friendship they accuse me, but I am a man of prayer.”

19 – Prophecy - His Side to be Pierced

Zechariah 12:10 “And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and supplication. They will look on me, the one they have pierced, and they will mourn for him as one mourns for an only child, and grieve bitterly for him as one grieves for a firstborn son.”

20 – Prophecy - Soldiers Cast Lots for Clothes

Psalms 22:18 “They divide my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing.”

21 – Prophecy - Not a Bone to be Broken

Psalms 34:20 “He protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.”

22 – Prophecy - To be Buried with the Rich

Isaiah 53:9 “He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth.”

23 – Prophecy - His Resurrection

Psalms 16:10 “You will not abandon me to the grave, nor will you let your Holy One see decay.”

01 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Place of Birth

Matthew 2:1 “After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem.”

02 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Heir to the Throne of David

Matthew 1:1 “A record of the genealogy of Jesus Christ the son of David, the son of Abraham.”

03 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Born of a Virgin

Matthew 1:18 “This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit.”

04 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Killing of Infants

Matthew 2:16 “When Herod realized that he had been outwitted by the Magi, he was furious, and he gave orders to kill all the boys in Bethlehem and its vicinity who were two years old and under, in accordance with the time he had learned from the Magi.”

05 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Escape into Egypt

Matthew 2:14 “So he got up, took the child and his mother during the night and left for Egypt.”

06 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Ministry in Galilee

Matthew 4:12-16 “When Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, he returned to Galilee. Leaving Nazareth, he went and lived in Capernaum, which was by the lake in the area of Zebulun and Naphtali– to fulfill what was said through the prophet Isaiah: “Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali, the way to the sea, along the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles– the people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned.”

07 - Prophecy Fulfilled - As a Prophet

John 6:14 “After the people saw the miraculous sign that Jesus did, they began to say, “Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world.”

08 - Prophecy Fulfilled - His Rejection by Jews

John 1:11 “He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him.”

09 - Prophecy Fulfilled - His Characteristics

Luke 2:52 “And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.”

10 - Prophecy Fulfilled - His Triumphal Entry

John 12:13-14 “They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, “Hosanna!” “Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!” “Blessed is the King of Israel!” “Jesus found a young donkey and sat upon it, as it is written.”

11 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Betrayed by a Friend

Mark 14:10 “Even my close friend, whom I trusted, he who shared my bread, has lifted up his heel against me.”

12 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Silent when Accused

Matthew 26:60-61 "But they did not find any, though many false witnesses came forward. Finally two came forward and declared, "This fellow said, 'I am able to destroy the temple of God and rebuild it in three days.'"

13 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Struck and Spat on

Mark 14:65 "Then some began to spit at him; they blindfolded him, struck him with their fists, and said, "Prophecy!" And the guards took him and beat him."

14 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Suffered Vicariously

Matthew 8:16-17 "When evening came, many who were demon - possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases."

15 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Crucified with Sinners

Matthew 27:38 "Two robbers were crucified with him, one on his right and one on his left."

16 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Hands and Feet Pierced

John 20:27 "Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe."

17 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Mocked and Insulted

Matthew 27:39-40 "Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!"

18 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Prays for his Enemies

Luke 23:34 “Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.” And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.”

19 - Prophecy Fulfilled - His Side to be Pierced

John 19:34 “Instead, one of the soldiers pierced Jesus' side with a spear, bringing a sudden flow of blood and water.”

20 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Soldiers Cast Lots for Clothes

Mark 15:24 “And they crucified him. Dividing up his clothes, they cast lots to see what each would get.”

21 - Prophecy Fulfilled - Not a Bone to be Broken

John 19:33 “But when they came to Jesus and found that he was already dead, they did not break his legs.”

22 - Prophecy Fulfilled - To be Buried with the Rich

Matthew 27:57-60 “As evening approached, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus. Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus' body, and Pilate ordered that it be given to him. Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and placed it in his own new tomb that he had cut out of the rock. He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away.”

23 - Prophecy Fulfilled - His Resurrection

Matthew 28:9 “Suddenly Jesus met them. “Greetings,” he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him.”
