- **Look at the Meaning**
 - a. Ask questions about the verse
 - b. Look up words or meanings that you don't understand
 - i. www.blueletterbible.org
 - c. Think about application.
- **Out Loud**
 - a. Use different "voices"
 - b. Emphasize different words
 - c. Use different emotions
 - d. Quote in front of an audience
 - e. Record your verses into a recorder
- **Actions**
 - a. Key words or hard to remember words
 - b. Engage all senses
 - c. Use your whole body
- **Draw pictures**
 - a. In your "mind's eye"
 - b. Key words
 - c. Hard to remember words
 - d. Highlight key phrases
 - e. Meaning of verses
 - f. The address and the verse

 - a. Display it in your house with art or written out.
 - b. Carry it around your neck

- Reviewing Verses – DO IT OFTEN!
 - a. Quote into a recorder and mark and review errors with a sheet protector
 - b. Review the verse from memory after 1 hour
 - c. Review the verse from memory and then read the verse
