- **Understand**

- Ask questions about the verse
- Look up words or meanings that you don't understand
 - www.blueletterbible.org
- Think about application.

- **Out Loud**

- Use different “voices”
- Emphasize different words
- Use different emotions
- Quote in front of an audience
- Record your verses into a recorder

- **Actions**

- Key words or hard to remember words
- Engage all senses
- Use your whole body

- **Draw pictures**

- In your “mind’s eye”
- Key words
- Hard to remember words
- Highlight key phrases
- Meaning of verses
- The address and the verse

- **Singing**

- The Palace method – One room and five objects

- Look for a pattern

- Playing Games

- Write it out

- Display it in your house with art or written out.
- Carry it around your neck

- Pray Scripture

- Adoration – Confession – Thanksgiving – Supplication

- Reviewing Verses – DO IT OFTEN!

- Quote into a recorder and mark and review errors with a sheet protector
- Review the verse from memory after 1 hour
- Review the verse from memory and then read the verse
